The entire state of ND is in need of volunteers to assist with the clean-up of homes and congregations affected by 2011 flood waters.

- If you would like to help in areas affected by the Souris River flooding, call 218-443-4970 to register from 8:00 am - 8:00 pm, Monday-Saturday and 1:00 pm - 8:00 pm Sunday.
- If you would like to help in Burleigh/Morton Counties or other parts of ND affected by flooding, call 800-950-2901 to register from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday-Thursday and 8:00 am - 12:00 pm on Friday.
- If you have access to the internet, you can skip the phone call. Go to www.lssnd.org and complete the Clean-up Volunteer Form and fax to 701-298-7763.
- Volunteers 16-17: parental consent and adult supervision *required*.
- Individuals 18 years of age or older, or groups are encouraged.
- Should have an updated tetanus shot.
- Housing will be provided if it is needed, although campers and tents are welcomed.
- If you are coming for a day trip, bring sack lunches and coolers of water so you stay hydrated!!!

Tools that would be helpful to bring, but not required, would include (make sure these are labeled):

- Rubber boots/rubber gloves
- Work gloves
- Goggles or safety glasses
- N-95 masks (minimum) or any mask that has 2 straps on it
- Hammers
- Brooms
- Large buckets
- Pliers
- Wonderbars or crowbars
